ABOUT THE WLCL...

A little over a year ago, I began to attend the White Lake Citizens League (WLCL) board meetings after an absence of nearly 12 years. After a couple of meetings, I realized that things had changed. Although the meetings were still sparsely attended, all those who did attend were very actively involved and getting things done. The WLCL's many activities include such projects as the Boat Parade, Fireworks, Membership, publishing of *The Current*, Communications, Fund Raising, the important work of the treasurer, as well as the important role as liaison to the Lake Improvement Board (your taxes and weed control).

Last month, I was asked to be President and I accepted, not so much because I'm now semi-retired and have some time to dedicate to the role, but because there were so many people involved and engaged in handling a share of the work that improves the quality of living on the lake.

One thing I found that has not changed was that funding for the fireworks, which cost nearly ten thousand dollars per year, is still in doubt. Funding for the fireworks comes in part from your membership fee and your general fund donations. Contributions from area businesses and WLCL fund raising events make up the balance.

This year, there is a very special fund raiser on Monday, May 26th, the "First Annual Memorial Day Pancake Breakfast." This is an opportunity for neighborhood involvement in a unique way. I'm old enough to remember when parents sat on the front porch, talked to their passing neighbors and watched their children play stick-ball in the street. (I grew up in Brooklyn, but I'm sure this memory is not unlike those you may cherish from old Detroit neighborhoods.)

The **First Annual Memorial Day Pancake Breakfast** is an opportunity for you and your neighbors, your friends and relatives to meet and talk to neighbors you might not have met yet and only waved to as their boat passed by.

I hope to see you there! I'll be the one giving out tips on the lost art of stick-ball.

WEED CONTROL PLAN FOR 2008

This year White Lake will again be treated with Sonar, as it was several years ago. That treatment was successful at controlling the two targeted nuisance weeds, Milfoil and Curly-Leaf Pondweed, which are <u>not native</u> to our lake. At the same time, Sonar does not affect those weeds that are native to the lake. Additionally, the control of Milfoil is expected to last for two seasons.

For maximum effectiveness, the treatment will be done in two stages. The first treatment will be in late April or early May and a second treatment will be done 3 to 4 weeks later. Other than Copper Sulfate for spot Algae control, no other weed control for the season is anticipated.

As with all treatments, approvals are obtained from the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) and the EPA and the applicators are state licensed. The shoreline will be posted with the water use restriction signs (yellow signs) prior to each application. For more information, see the insert in this newsletter.

A major WLCL tradition is the fireworks display, funded by our generous members and local business contributors.

The 2008 Fireworks will cost WLCL over \$10,000, and the board is concerned about our ability to continue to fund this event and maintain other important activities.

Fireworks contributions have not kept pace with cost increases in recent years, and once again the 2009 display is in

jeopardy. In order to reserve our preferred dates, the contractor requires a commitment from WLCL at the time of each year's display. The board will review contributions received through JUNE 26 and make a decision on commitments for next year at that time.

BLOCK CAPTAINS NEEDED!

We'll soon be starting the WLCL membership drive for 2008, and we'd like to begin by thanking the folks who helped out in 2007! We need more volunteers from the membership to cover open territories and help us personally contact everyone on the lake.

We have divided the area into 40 "Block" territories, so that each volunteer doesn't have to make too many individual contacts. We have special needs on the east side of the lake, particularly on and around Ridge Road.

The work is not complicated, and by starting early, you can pace your contacts so that the assignment won't be a great burden in your busy schedule. Here's what the job entails:

Contacting each resident at the waterfront addresses on your block list. Most blocks contain between 10 and 20 homes to be contacted.

The purpose of the contacts is as follows:

- Solicit them for membership dues and a fireworks donation.
- Update our roster for ownership name changes.
- Collect e-mail addresses (and changes of e-mail address) for all of your neighbors, whether or not they choose to join WLCL.
- Recruit people who would like to help by volunteering.

We will be having a meeting soon to get Block Captains briefed and equipped with forms and materials to make the contacts easy. Accordingly, we need to fill our open territories as soon as possible.
