- 2. Financial Report (C. Neville)
  - a. April receipts \$485 from 6 members
  - b. Spend was \$13 on credit card fees
  - c. April Yr to date receipts of \$1,345 from 18 members vs \$2,745 from 41 members last yr.
  - d. April yr to date expenses were \$1,000 less than last year due no winter carnival and no fireworks permit yet
